
ORK Talkabout Equalities Profile

This document aims to provide a summary of the equalities profile of the Talkabout citizen's panel. Where possible comparisons have been made to the York Profile with data sourced from the 2021 Census.

Panel Information

The current panel consists of 1095 members, panel members are asked a number of personal questions when signing up which they can choose not to answer. Since October 2022; 17 new members have joined the panel and 9 have been withdrawn.



Gender and Transgender

47% of the panel gave male as their gender and 50% female with 1% selecting prefer not to say (based on 878 responses). 1% of the panel identified as transgender and 0% indentified as gender variant.

Chart 1 reflects the grouped ethnic profile of panel members and chart 2 presents a further breakdown of Black and Minority Ethnicities to look in detail if these are proportionately represented. Both have been compared to York as a whole.
