What information we will collect

Your thoughts and opinions about the proposals.

What will we do with the information/why do we want it?

We will use the information you give us to form the final scheme which will be considered along with the responses to this consultation by the executive member for transport and planning.

Any information we use in presentations or reports will be anonymised and so will not identify any individuals. Some of the responses may relate to the practices of individual businesses, such as loading arrangements and needs, so it may be possible for readers to link those comments to the business that supplied them. However, these will not be linked to any other responses given as part of the consultation. So it may be possible for a member of the public to determine the loading needs of an individual business, but they would not be able to determine how that business responded to any other aspects of the consultation.

We will ensure that it is used for no other purpose and is not disclosed to a third party i.e. other companies or individuals unless we are required to do so by law, for the prevention of crime and the detection of fraud, etc.

Why do we need personal information from you?

We only use your personal information with your explicit and informed consent for the purposes described/as set out in this Privacy Notice, in order to improve services for particular groups of people where they identify appropriate concerns.

Where will the information be kept?

We will keep the information you give us and your personal data in the council's secure network drive and make sure it is unavailable to anyone who should not have access to it.

How long will we keep the information for?

Up to 3 years then we will securely destroy it
