

City of York Annual Parking Report 2018/19

Under the Local Government Transparency code City of York Council is required to publish or place a link providing information on annual parking income & expenditure and how the surplus is re-invested, and also the number of controlled on & off street parking spaces.

Introduction

City of York Council is a unitary local authority providing services to around 200,000 people in an area covering approximately 105 square miles. As well as the City of York, the main towns and villages are Bishopthorpe, Copmanthorpe, Rufforth, Upper Poppleton, Nether Poppleton, Skelton, Wigginton, Haxby, Strensall, Stockton on the Forest, Dunnington, Elvington and Wheldrake.

Parking in York

The Council operates 13 off-street car parks (2772 spaces), two coach parks (62 spaces) and 6 park and ride sites (5020 spaces). In addition, there are 640 spaces available for on-street parking (of which 380 are in residents parking areas). The council also has 63 residents' priority parking schemes (Respark) throughout the city which give priority to residents, their visitors and local businesses. There are 5780 spaces, including 380 which are also Pay & Display. For more information on residents parking see
