

## **City of York Annual Parking Report 2021/22**

Under the Local Government Transparency code City of York Council is required to publish or place a link providing information on annual parking income & expenditure and how the surplus is re-invested, and also the number of controlled on & off street parking spaces.

### **Introduction**

City of York Council is a unitary local authority providing services to around 200,000 people in an area covering approximately 105 square miles. As well as the City of York, the main towns and villages are Bishopthorpe, Copmanthorpe, Rufforth, Upper Poppleton, Nether Poppleton, Skelton, Wigginton, Haxby, Strensall, Stockton on the Forest, Dunnington, Elvington and Wheldrake.

### **Parking in York**

The Council operates 13 off-street car parks (2742 spaces), two coach parks (62 spaces) and 6 park and ride sites (5002 spaces). In addition, there are 640 spaces available for on-street parking (of which 380 are in residents parking areas). The council also has 67 residents' priority parking schemes (Respark) throughout the city which give priority to residents, their visitors and local businesses. There are 6991 spaces, including 381 which are also Pay & Display.

Parking fines are issued to owners of vehicles who breach the council's parking regulations. Payment of parking fines can be made on-line via the council's website, by debit/credit card or by cash.

## Parking Account 2021/22

The council is also required to publish details of the annual income and expenditure on the parking account and to show how the surplus has been re-invested in council services.

The surplus was reinvested to support the council's public transport and highways budgets where overall expenditure was significantly higher than the surplus.
