Privacy Notice for Moving Traffic Enforcement

This privacy notice was completed in July 2023 and will be regularly reviewed. When we use your personal data, CYC complies with data protection legislation and is the registered 'Controller'. Our data protection notification is registered with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) – reference **Z5809563**.

Why is information being collected?

To seek support and comments from the public to apply for the Moving Traffic Enforcement powers and seek views on the pilot location that has an existing restriction in place where these powers would allow us to enforce this restriction with ANPR cameras.

What information will be collected?

We are collecting score markings and comments only for applying for these powers, the pilot scheme and comments for other locations.

What will we do with the information?

The information we collect will be included in presentations, statistics and reports. Any presentations, reports and statistics for publication or use outside of the authorised council staff, will be anonymised and cannot be linked back to you or individuals. Reports containing anonymous information may also be shared with the public and other organisations.

We will keep the information you give us in CYC's secure network drive and make sure it can only be accessed by authorised staff.

How long will we keep the information?
