

## **York Summary**


- York has 198,051 residents with 9.8% from a black and minority ethnic community group. 84% are in good health, with 15.3% stating they have some limitation in day to day activities.
- Males can expect to live to 79.6 and females to 83.1 years of age. 28.3% of the population are classed as healthy eating adults, however 23% are classed as obese.
- There are 83,552 houses in York with 66% of residents owning their own home outright or via a mortgage, 18% are private renters and 14% social tenants.
- 73.5% of residents have a NVQ level 1-4 qualification with 18% having no qualification at all.
- 4,490 (12.5%) children live in poverty. 5,530 of 33,415 (16.5%) pensioners receive pension credit.
- 7.9% of the working population claim out of work benefits and 1.3% claim job seekers allowance.
- Telephone is the favoured communication channel for contacting the council with 44% of contacts from York residents. Face to face accounts for 11% and self serve accounts for 6%.





## **Ward Summary**


- Acomb has 8,604 residents with 4.5% from a black and minority ethnic community group. This compares to 7,729 residents and a BME proportion of 2.1% in 2001.
- 82.2% are in good health, with 17.3% stating they have some limitation in day to day activities.
- 30.5% of adults are single and 50.1% are married.
- Males can expect to live to 78.8 and females to 81.7 years of age. 24.1% of the population are classed as healthy eating adults, however 27.2% are classed as obese.
- There are 3,520 houses in this ward with 76% of residents owning their own home outright or via a mortgage, 8% are private renters and 15% social tenants.
- 65.2% of residents have a NVQ level 1-4 qualification with 24.1% having no qualification at all.
- 260 (13.5%) children live in poverty. 275 of 1,553 (17.7%) pensioners receive pension credit.
- 9.3% of the working population claim out of work benefits and 1.5% claim job seekers allowance. There are 84 JSA claimants in Acomb with 30 claiming over 6 months.
- Telephone is the favoured communication channel for contacting the council at 48%. Face to face accounts for 11% and self serve accounts for 2%.


