**Deprivation score (Multiple):** measures the deprivation for small areas across England, based on seven domains of deprivation (Income; Employment; Education, Skills & Training; Health & Disability; Crime; Barriers to Housing & Services; Living Environment). Each area is given an Index of Multiple Deprivation Score. A higher score indicates a greater level of deprivation.

**Alcohol related hospital admission (narrow definition):** admission to hospital where the main reason for admission to hospital was attributable to alcohol.

**Alcohol related hospital admission (broad definition):** admissions to hospital where the primary reason for hospital admission or a secondary diagnosis was linked to alcohol.

**Domains of Deprivation - Health Deprivation and Disability:** measures the risk of premature death and the impairment of quality of life through poor physical or mental health.
