


# Westfield Ward Profile



## York Summary

- York has 204,439 residents with 9.8% from a black and minority ethnic community group. 83.9% are in good health, with 15.3% stating that they have some limitation in day to day activities.
- £537.41 was the Average Weekly Household Income in 2011/2012 (£405.83 in 2007/2008).
- 66% own their own home, either outright or with a mortgage, 18% are private renters and 14% are social tenants.
- 73.5% of residents have a NVQ level 1 - 4 qualification and 18.0% have no qualifications at all.
- 10.6% of children live in poverty and there are 9.0% of households in fuel poverty.
- 6.9% of the working population (aged 16-64) claim out of work benefits and 0.8% claim job seekers allowance.




## Ward Summary

- Westfield has 13,859 residents with 5.6% from a black and minority ethnic community group. 78.9% are in good health, with 18.8% stating that they have some limitation in day to day activities.
- £466.89 was the Average Weekly Household Income in 2011/2012 (£353.33 in 2007/2008).
- 57% own their own home, either outright or with a mortgage, 9% are private renters and 32% are social tenants.
- 63.6% of residents have a NVQ level 1 - 4 qualification and 27.8% have no qualifications at all.
- 19.4% of children live in poverty and there are 8.9% of households in fuel poverty.
- 11.7% of the working population claim out of work benefits and 1.5% claim job seekers allowance.





## Population by Age














## Hours Worked

## Qualifications











## Household Composition






### Benefit Claimant Numbers Working age Population (16-64)


### Benefit Claimant Rate Working age Population (16-64)

### Total Benefit Claimant Rate (Age and Gender) Working age Population (16-64)









### Child Poverty


The proportion of children living in families in receipt of out-of-work (means-tested) benefits or in receipt of tax credits where their reported income is less than 60 per cent of UK median income.

### Fuel Poverty


A household is said to be fuel poor if it needs to spend more than 10% of its income on fuel to maintain an adequate standard of warmth.

Pension Credit is an income-related benefit made up of 2 parts - Guarantee Credit and Savings Credit.






The IMD measures and rates a number of different domains affecting quality of life including income, employment, education and skills, health and disability, crime, barriers to services and quality of living environments.





### Childhood Obesity











### Total Crime and Total Anti-Social Behaviour per 1,000 population





## ASB per 1,000 population




## Crime Rate per 1,000 population


### Average Weekly Homecare Hours by Client Type and Age




## Homecare Clients by Type and Age





<p><b>Experian Groups</b></p> <p><b>M Family Basics</b> Families with children, aged 25 to 40, limited resources, some own low cost homes, some rent from social landlords.</p> <p><b>L Transient Renters</b> Private renters, low length of residence, low cost housing, singles and sharers, older terraces.</p> <p><b>K Modest Traditions</b> Mature age, homeowners, affordable housing, kids are grown up, suburban locations.</p> <p><b>N Vintage Value</b> Elderly, living alone, low income, small houses and flats, need support.</p> <p><b>H Aspiring Homemakers</b> Younger households, full-time employment, private suburbs, affordable housing costs, starter salaries.</p> <p><b>F Senior Security</b> Elderly singles and couples, homeowners, comfortable homes, additional pensions above state, don't like new technology.</p> <p><b>E Suburban Stability</b> Older families, some adult children at home, suburban mid-range homes, 3 bedrooms, have lived at same address some years.</p>
<p><b>Experian Types</b></p> <p><b>M56 Solid Economy</b> Families with children, renting from social landlord, pockets of social housing, lower wage service roles, relatively stable finances.</p> <p><b>L51 Make Do &amp; Move On</b> Late 20s and early 30s, singles and cohobitees without children, low length of residence, rent low value properties, search for jobs online.</p> <p><b>L52 Midlife Stopgap</b> Homesharers and singles, in employment, don't have children, average age 45, privately renting affordable homes.</p> <p><b>K46 Self Supporters</b> Aged 46-65, singles living alone, income typically £20-25k, own 2 or 3 bedroom small homes, still working.</p> <p><b>N61 Estate Veterans</b> Average age 75, often living alone, long term social renters of current home, living on estates with some deprivation, low income.</p> <p><b>M54 Childcare Squeeze</b> Married or cohabiting couples, likely to have pre-school children, outgoings high in proportion to income, own low value homes, both parents working.</p> <p><b>O63 Streetwise Singles</b> Singles and sharers, low cost social flats, 1 or 2 bedrooms, urban and fringe locations, routine occupations.</p> <p><b>M55 Families with Needs</b> Cohabiting couples &amp; singles with kids, areas with high unemployment, low household income, small socially rented terraces and semis, moves tend to be within local community.</p> <p><b>K47 Offspring Overspill</b> Pre-retirement, families with adult children, individual incomes not high, better off if children are contributing, own 3 bed semis and terraces.</p> <p><b>K48 Down-to-Earth Owners</b> Older married couples, children have left home, have lived in same house for 25 years, own affordable semis and terraces, living within means.</p>
