

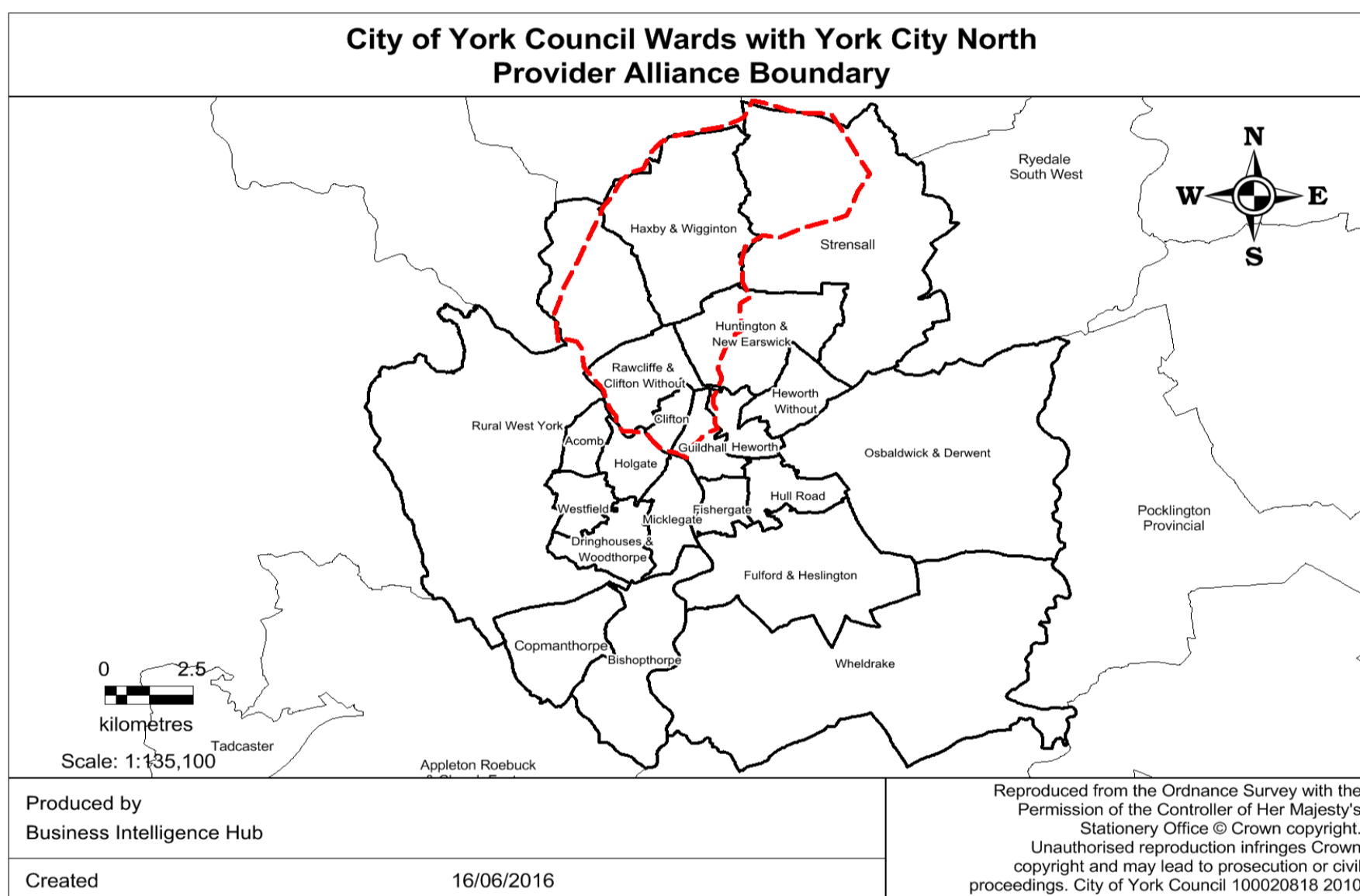


## Provider Alliance Boundary: York City North

### York Summary

- York has 208,367 residents with 5.7% from a black and minority ethnic community group. 83.9% are in good health, with 15.3% stating that they have some limitation in day to day activities.
- 66% own their own home, either outright or with a mortgage, 18% are private renters and 14% are social tenants.
- 73.5% of residents have a NVQ level 1 - 4 qualification and 18.0% have no qualifications at all.
- 9.7% of children are in child poverty (7.8% of children live in a household where a parent or guardian claims an out-of-work benefit) and there are 11.5% of households in fuel poverty.
- 1.7% of the working population (aged 16-64) claim out of work benefits and 0.2% claim job seekers allowance.

### City of York Council Wards with York City North Provider Alliance Boundary



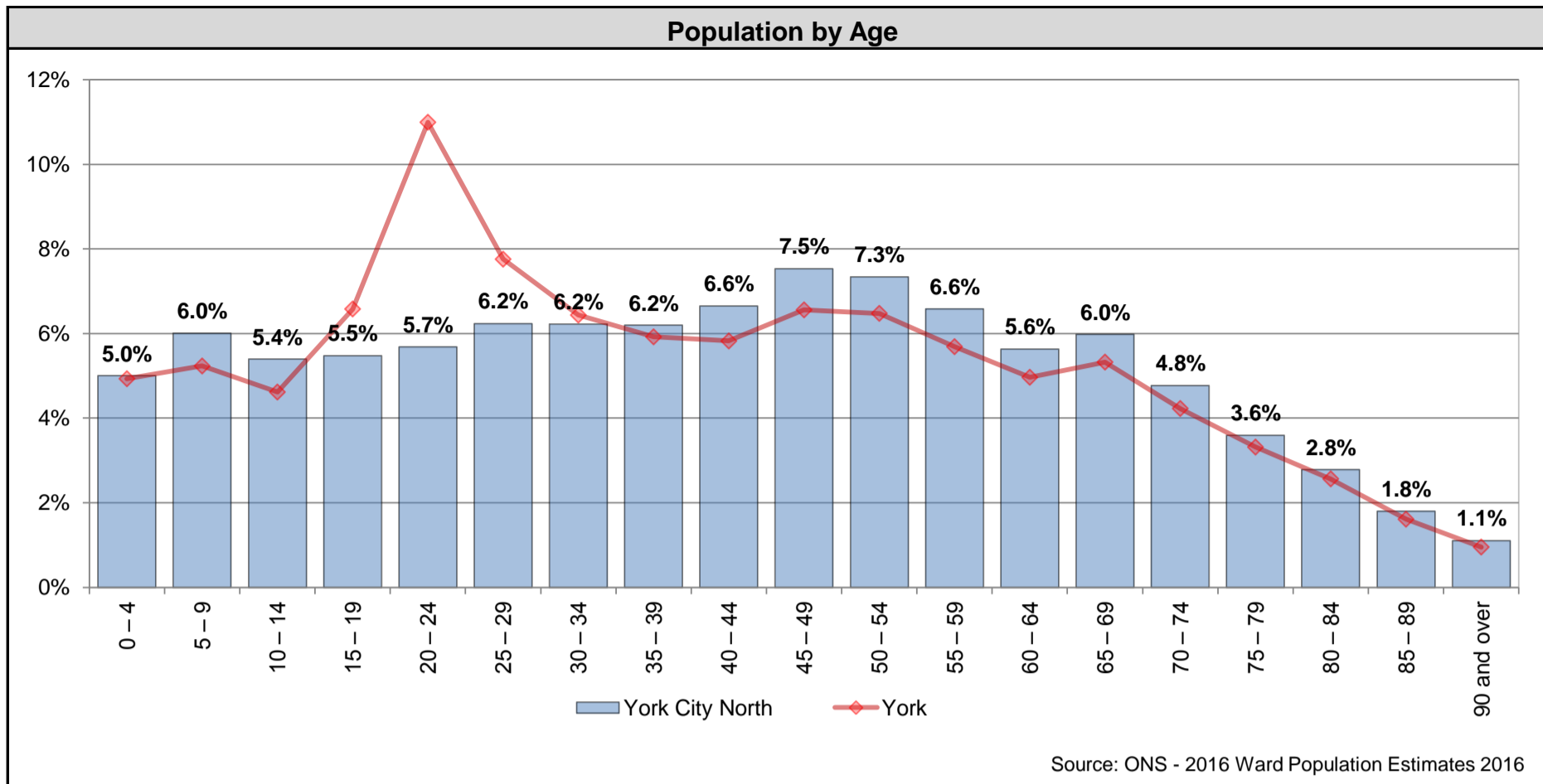

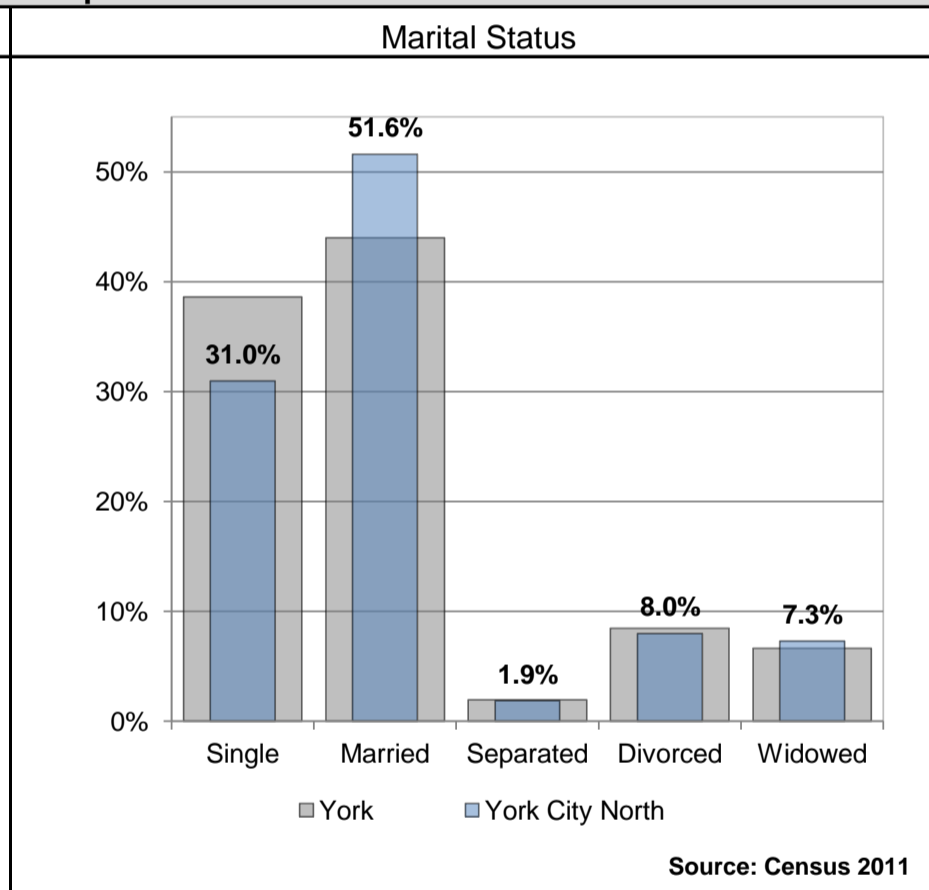
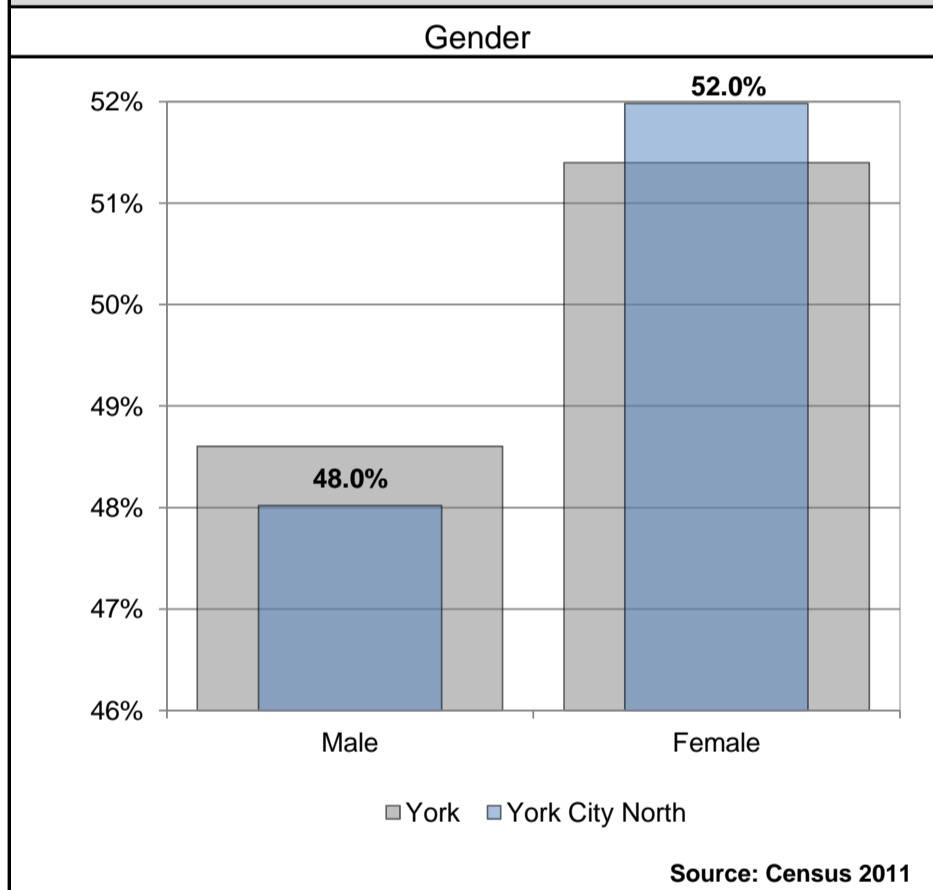
- York City North has 42,739 residents with 7.76% from a black and minority ethnic community group. 84.0% are in good health, with 15.5% stating that they have some limitation in day to day activities.
- 75% own their own home, either outright or with a mortgage, 14% are private renters and 10% are social tenants.
- 72.9% of residents have a NVQ level 1 - 4 qualification and 18.7% have no qualifications at all.
- 7.1% of children live in poverty and there are 8.1% of households in fuel poverty.
- 0.3% of the working population claim out of work benefits and 0.2% claim job seekers allowance.



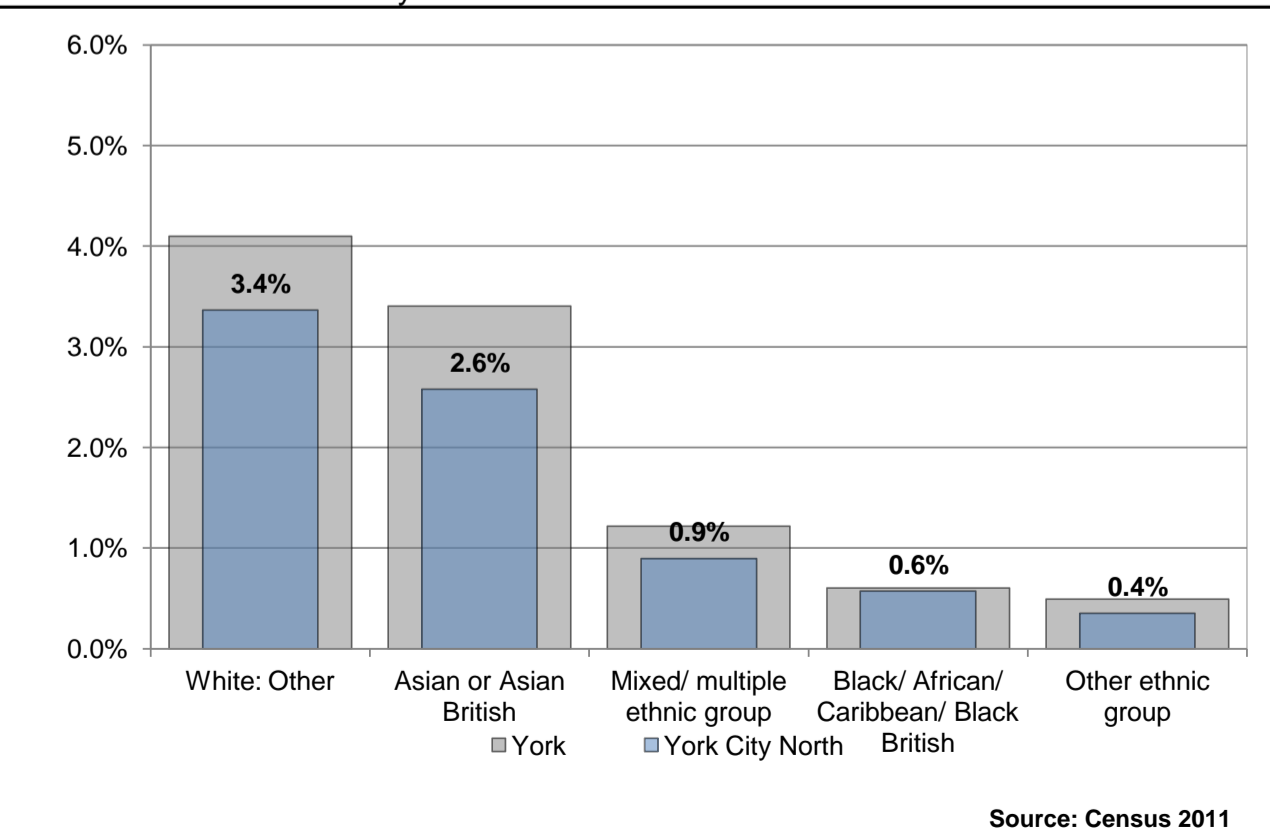
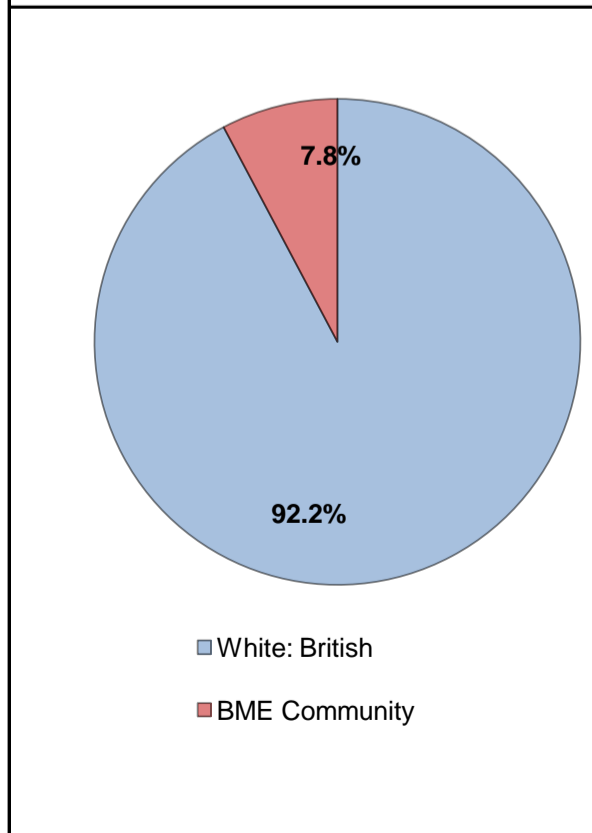

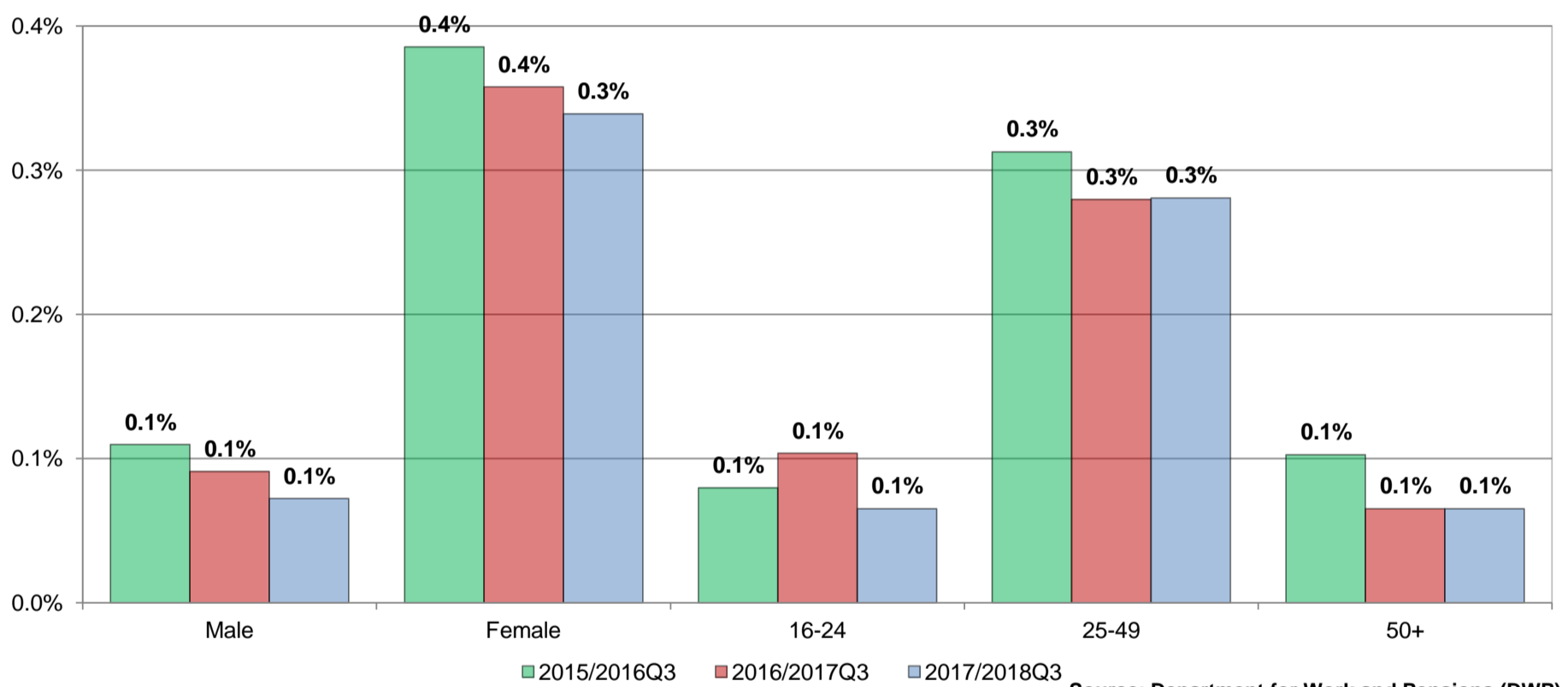
### Economy

Benefit Claimant Rate - Working age population (16-64)



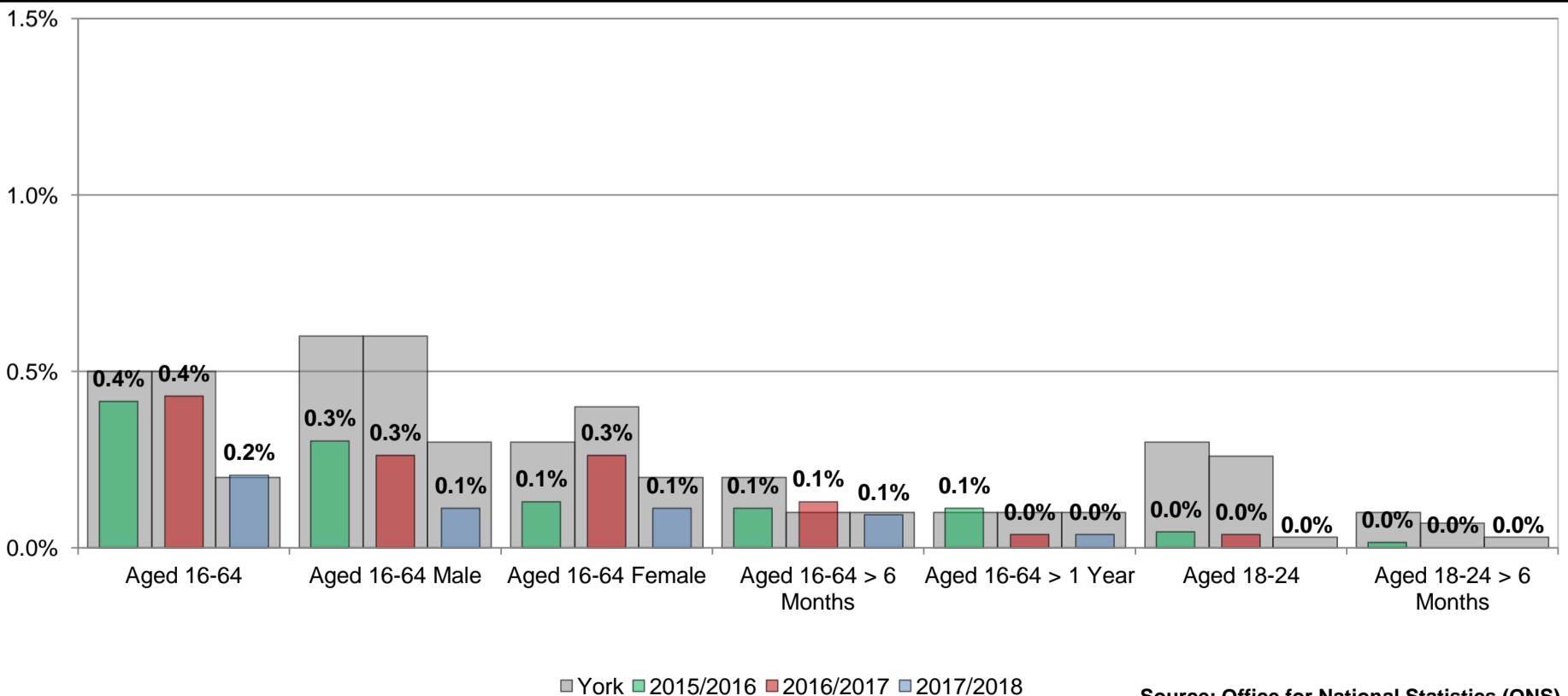

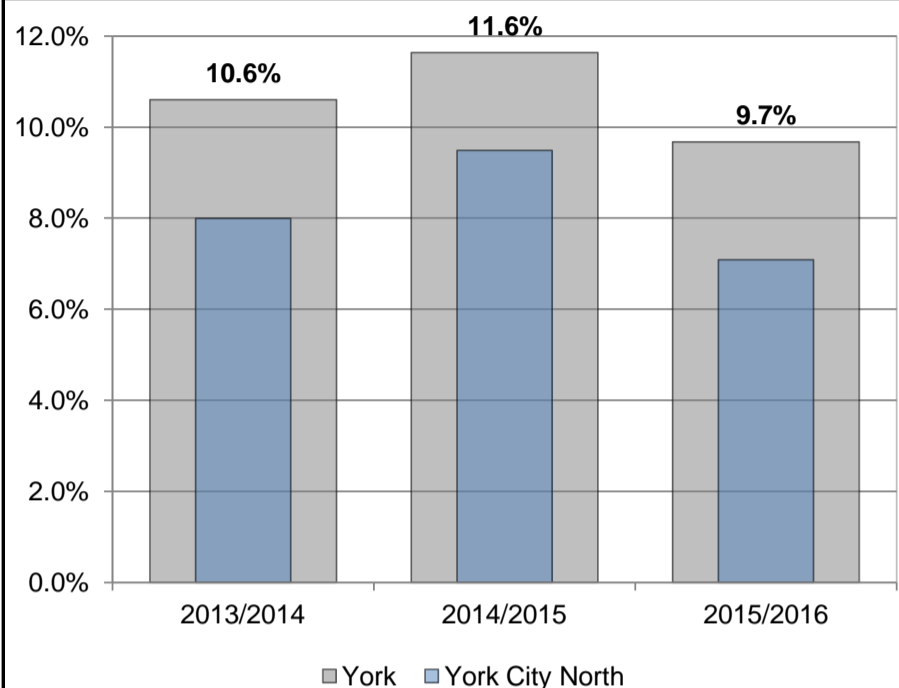

The proportion of children living in families in receipt of out-of-work (means-tested) benefits or in receipt of tax credits where their reported income is less than 60 per cent of UK median income.

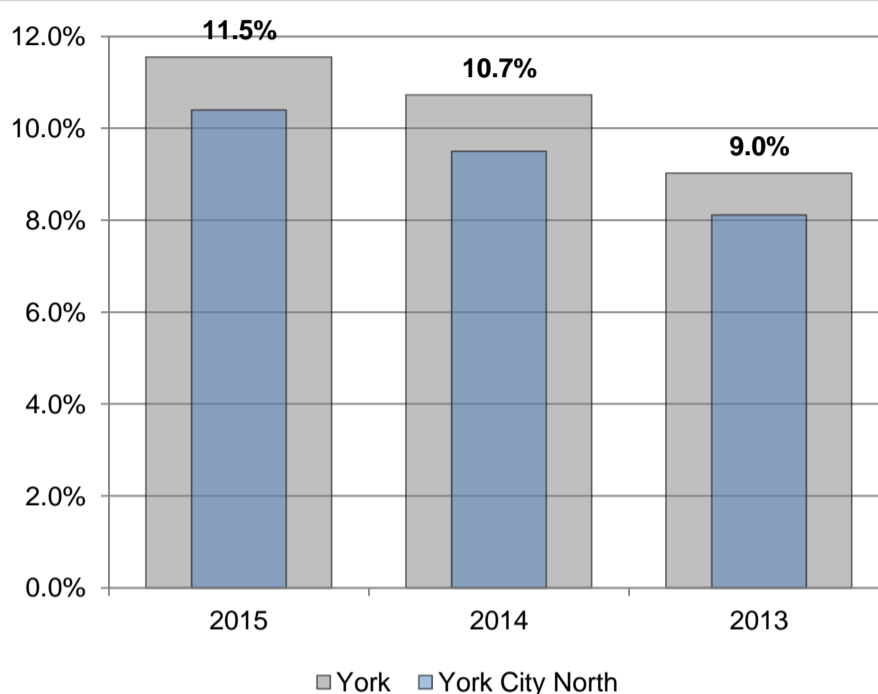

#### Fuel Poverty

The Low Income High Costs indicator is a twin indicator consisting of:

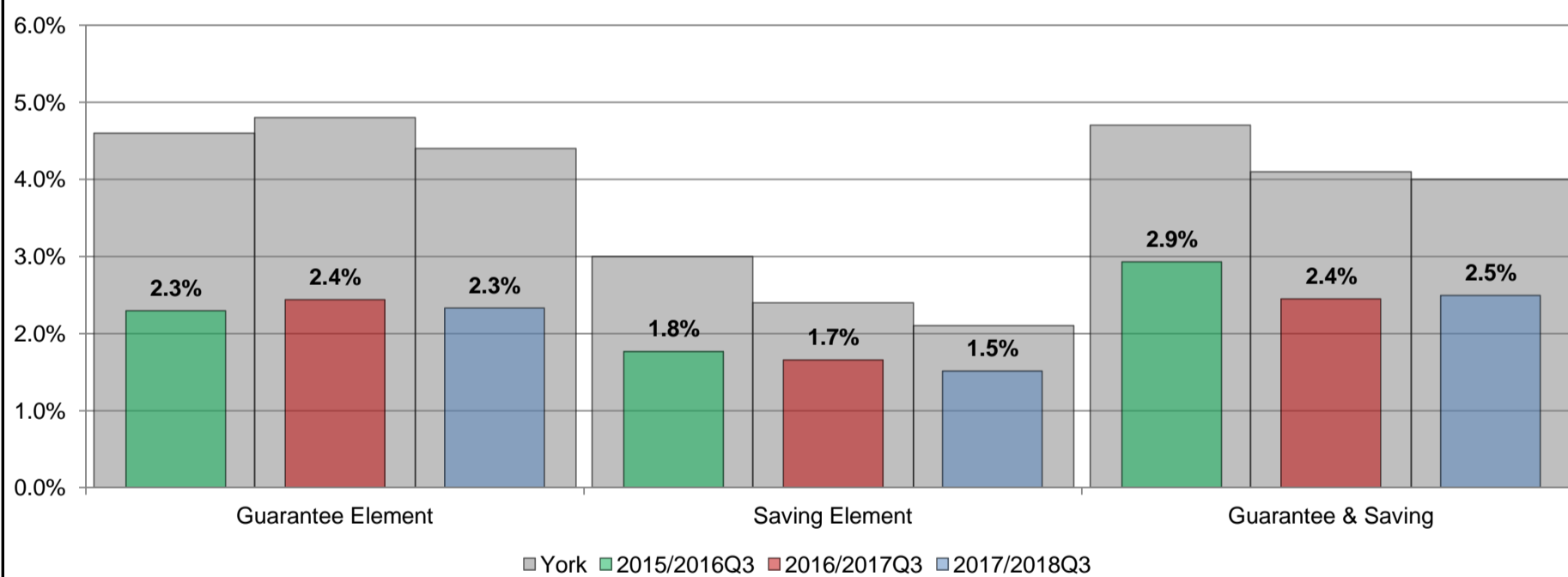
- the number of households that have both low incomes and high fuel costs; and
- the depth of fuel poverty amongst these fuel poor households. This is measured through a fuel poverty gap which represents the difference between the required fuel costs for each household and the median required fuel costs.

### Pension Credit

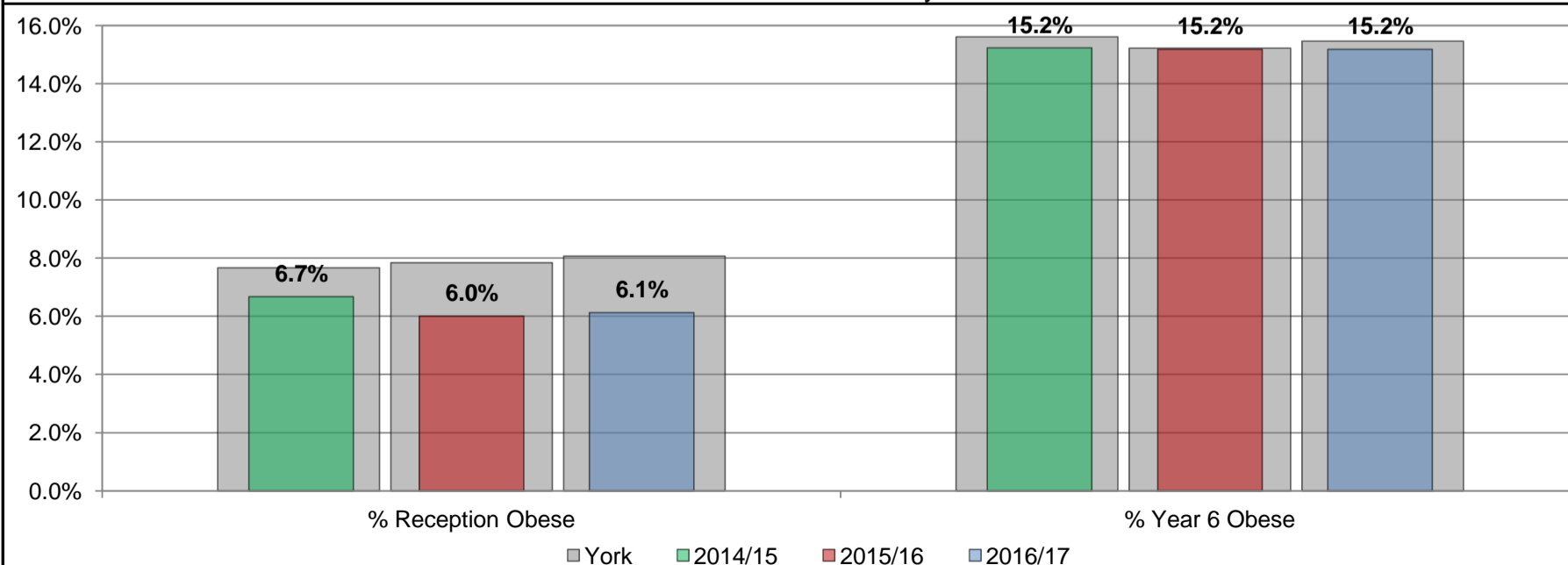
Pension Credit is an income-related benefit made up of 2 parts - Guarantee Credit and Savings Credit.

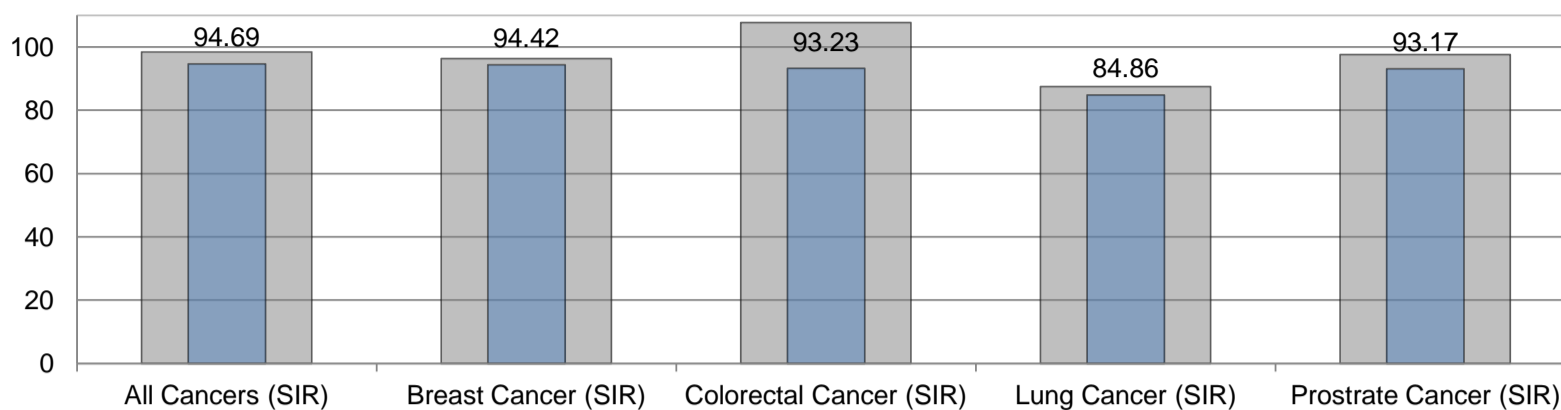

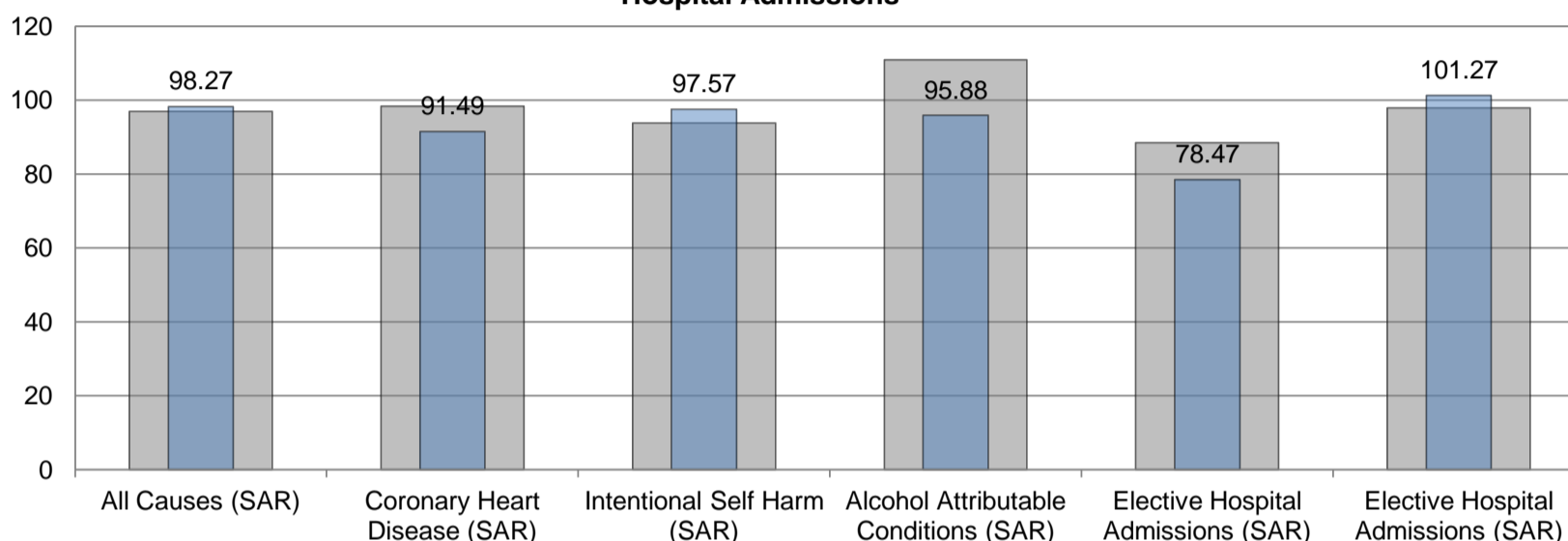

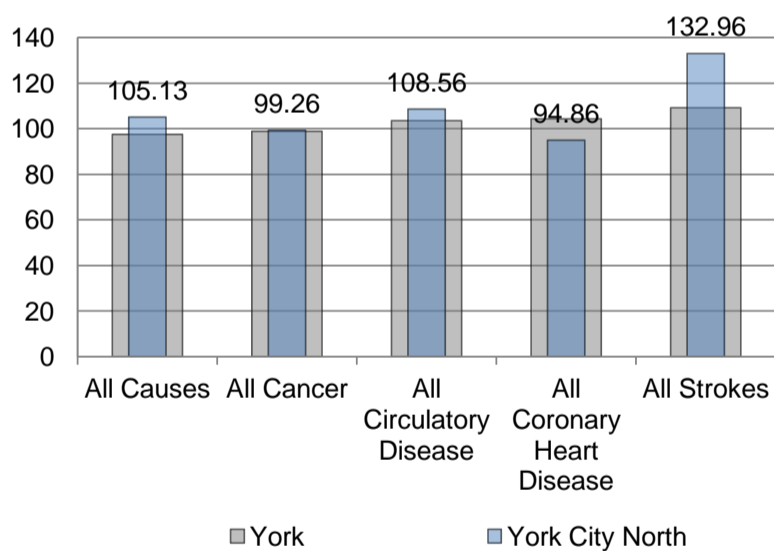


5 year aggregated data 2011/12 - 2015/16

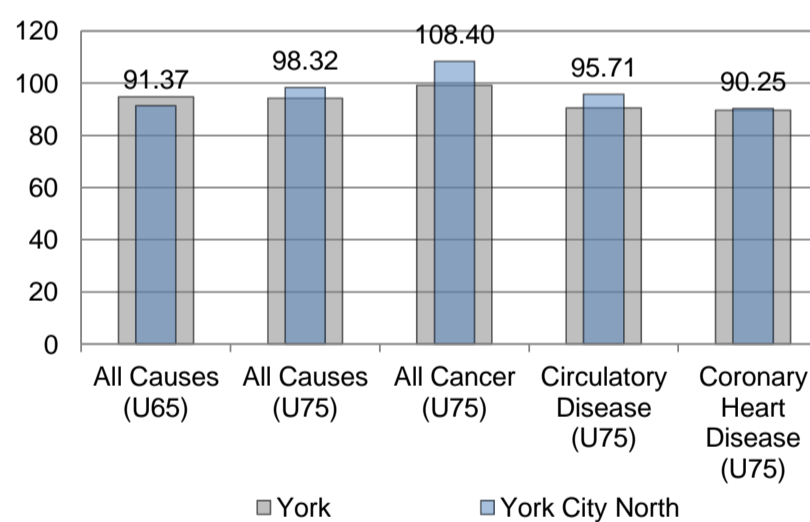
### Mortality

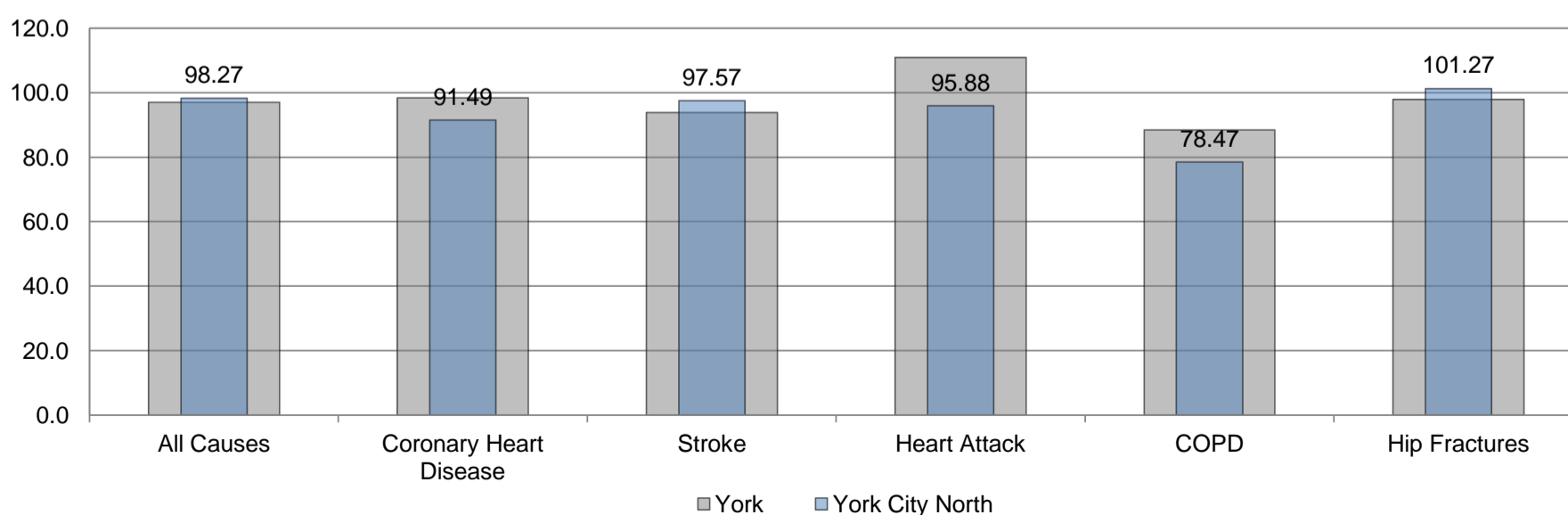
### Premature Mortality

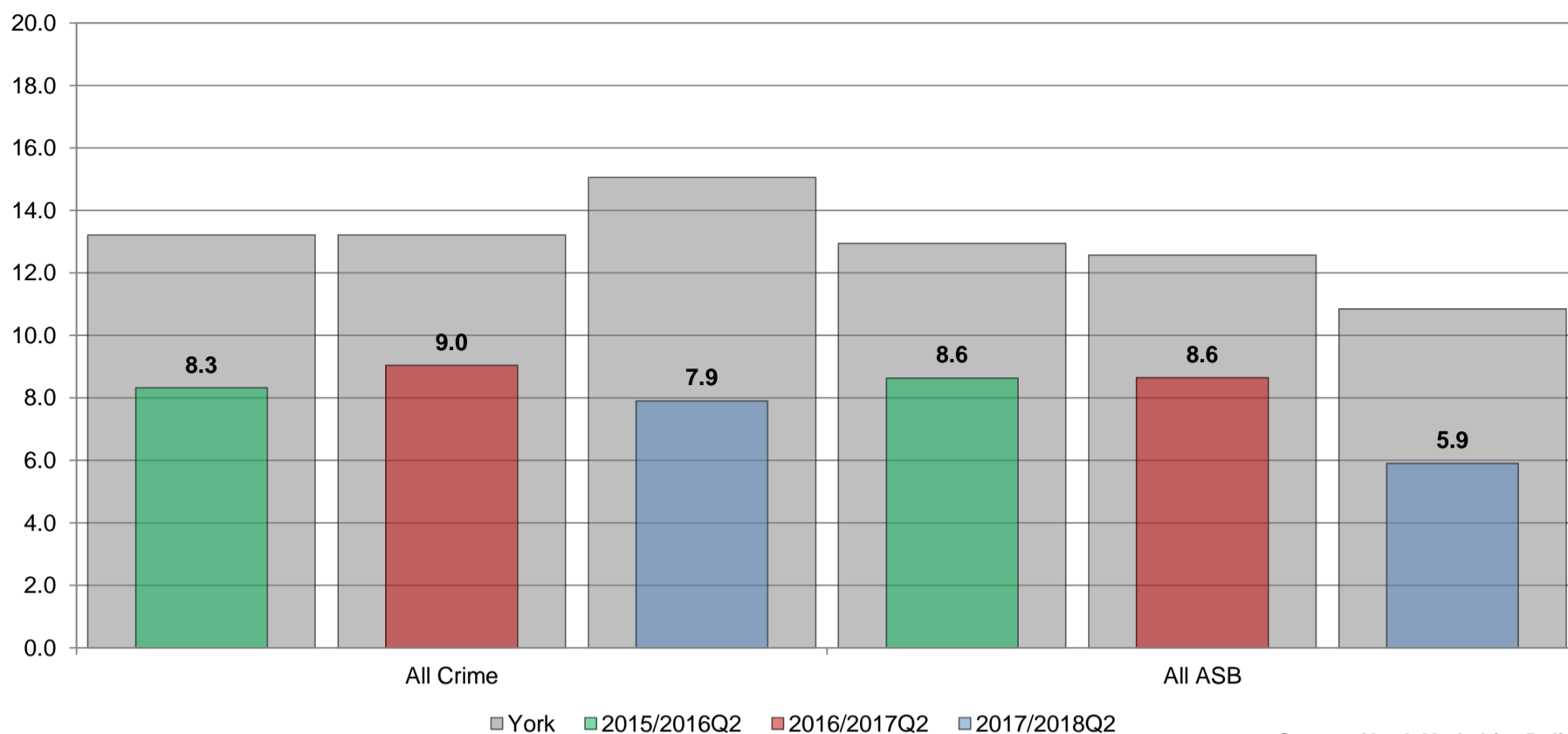

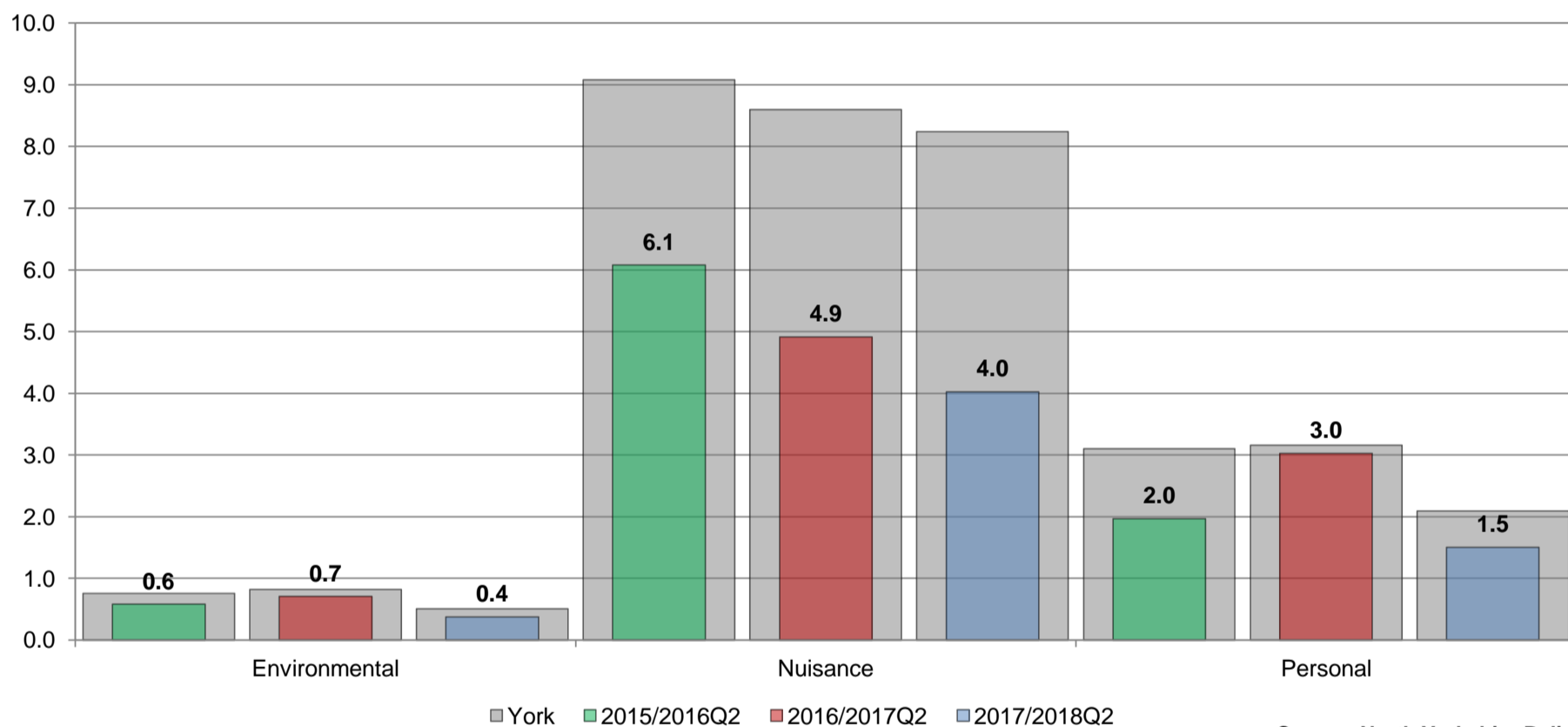
## Crime and Anti-Social Behaviour

Total Crime and Total Anti-Social Behaviour per 1,000 population



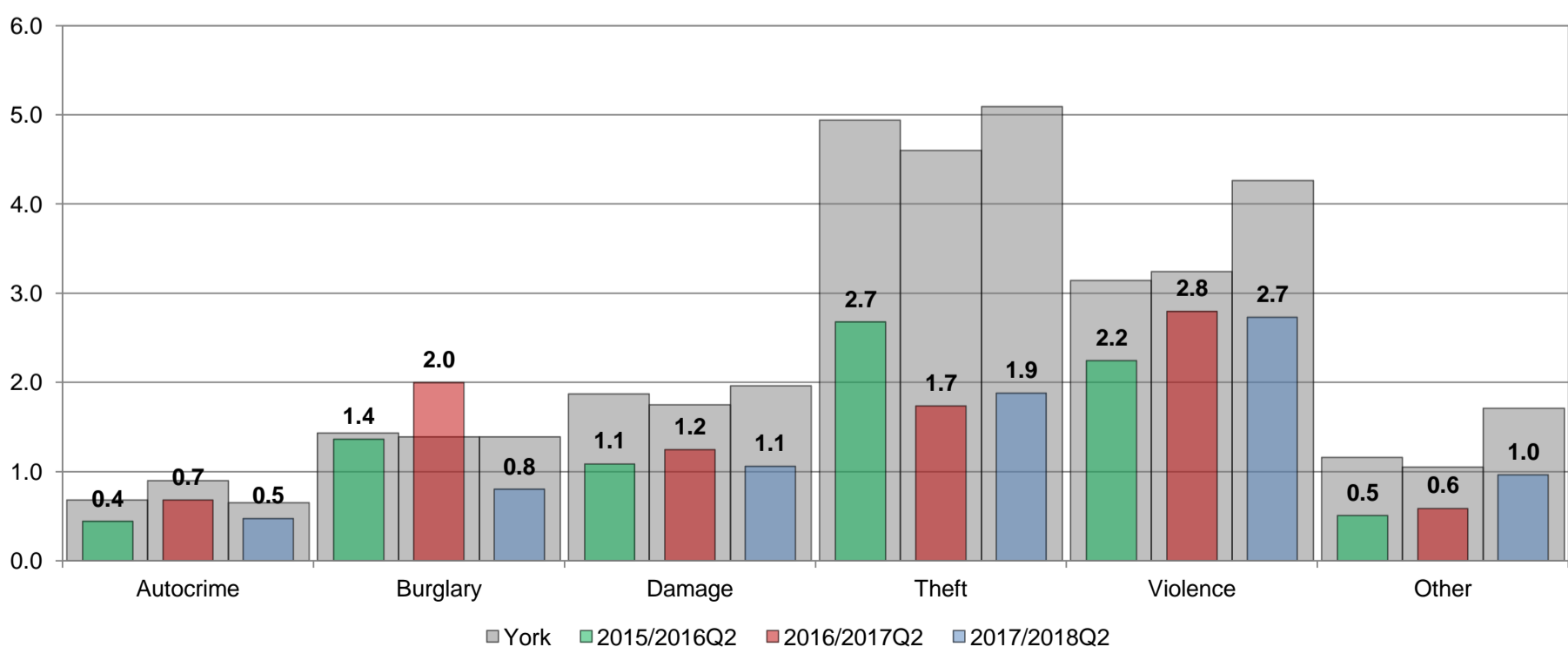

Crime rate per 1,000 population



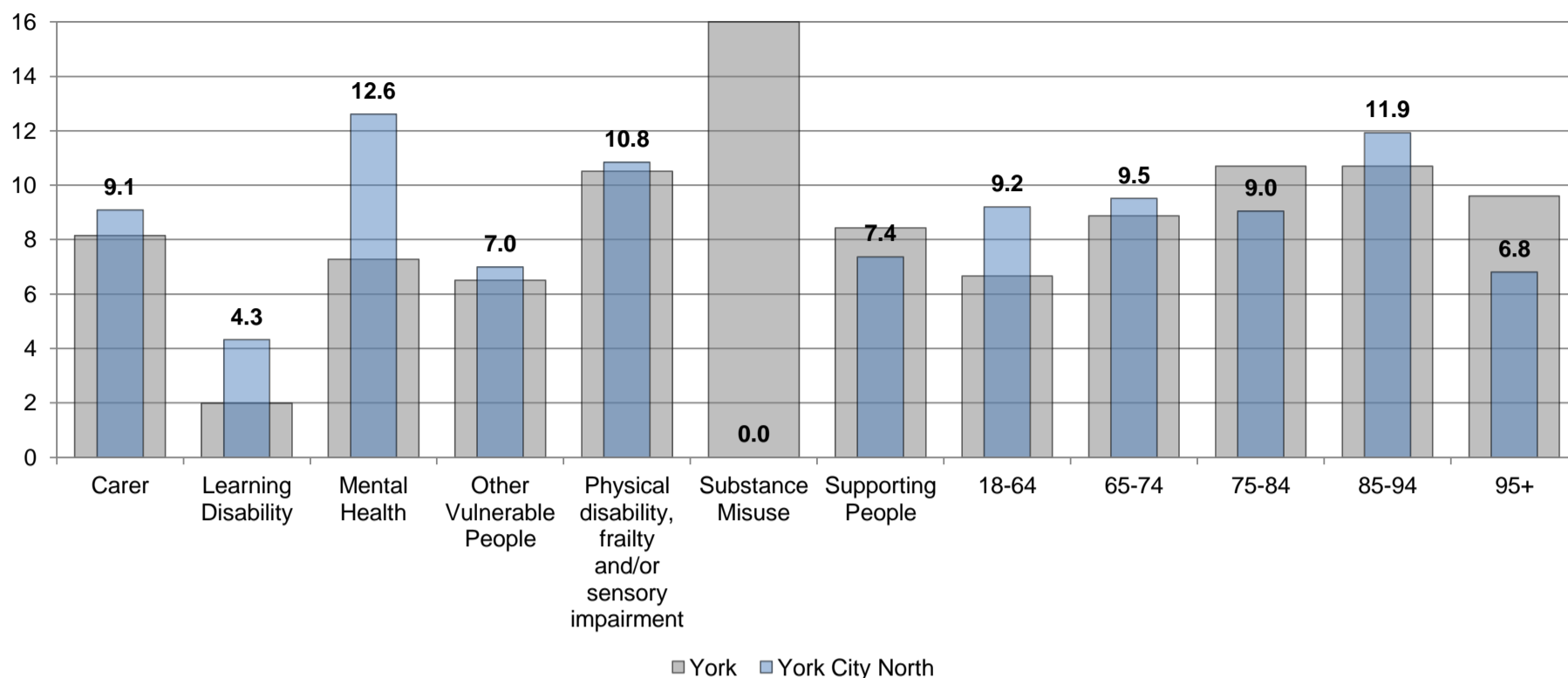

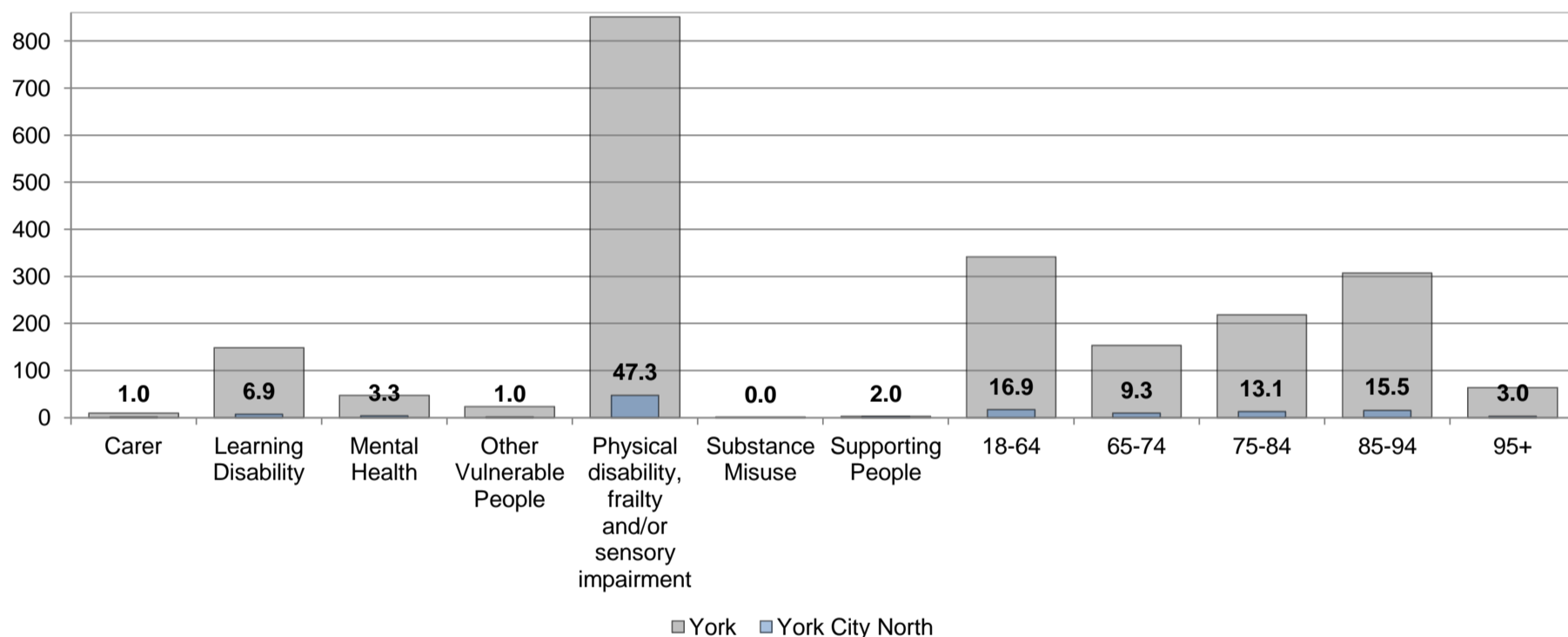

Average Weekly Homecare Hours by Client Type and Age



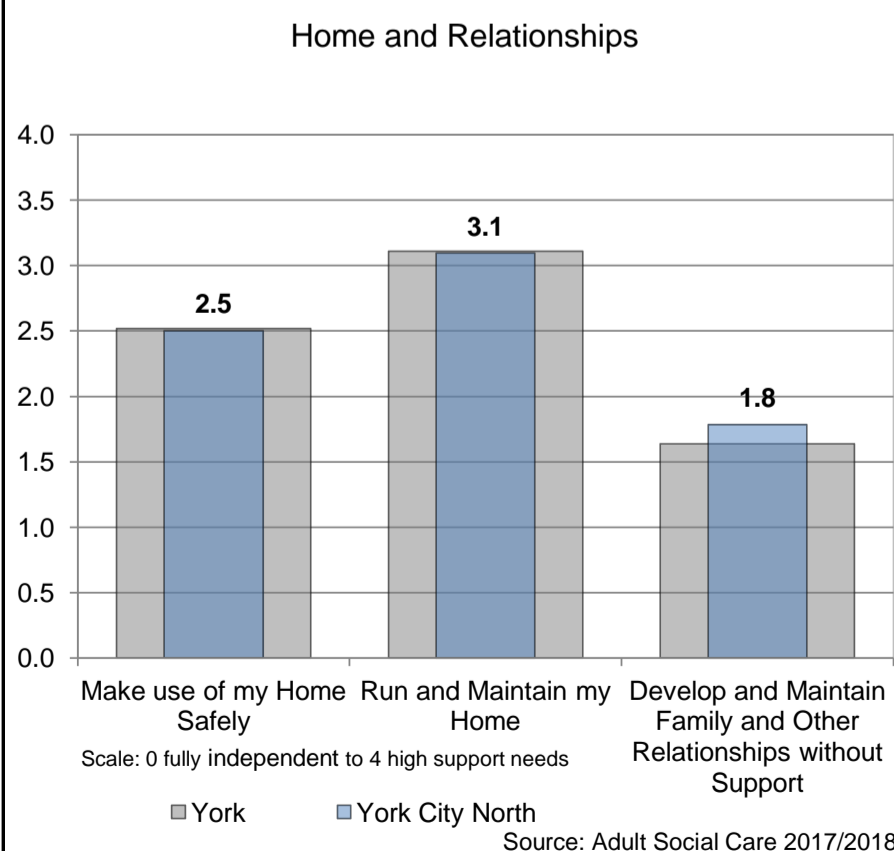

Average Number of Homecare Clients by Type and Age

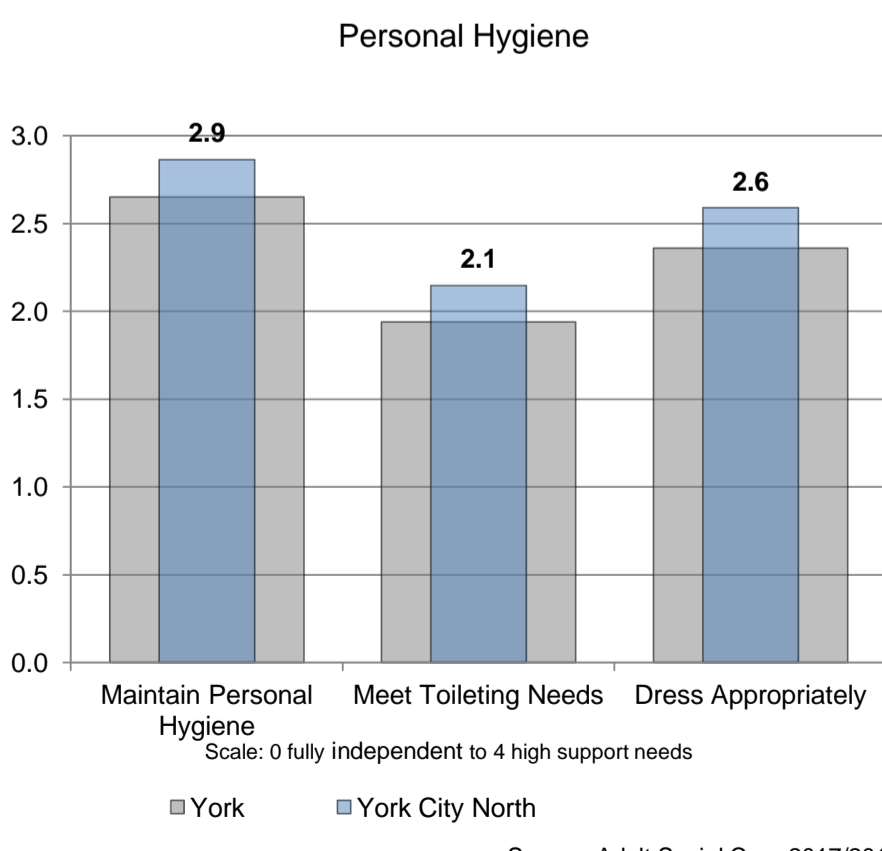

Average Score Recorded by Customers for Supported Self Assessments Completed in Period



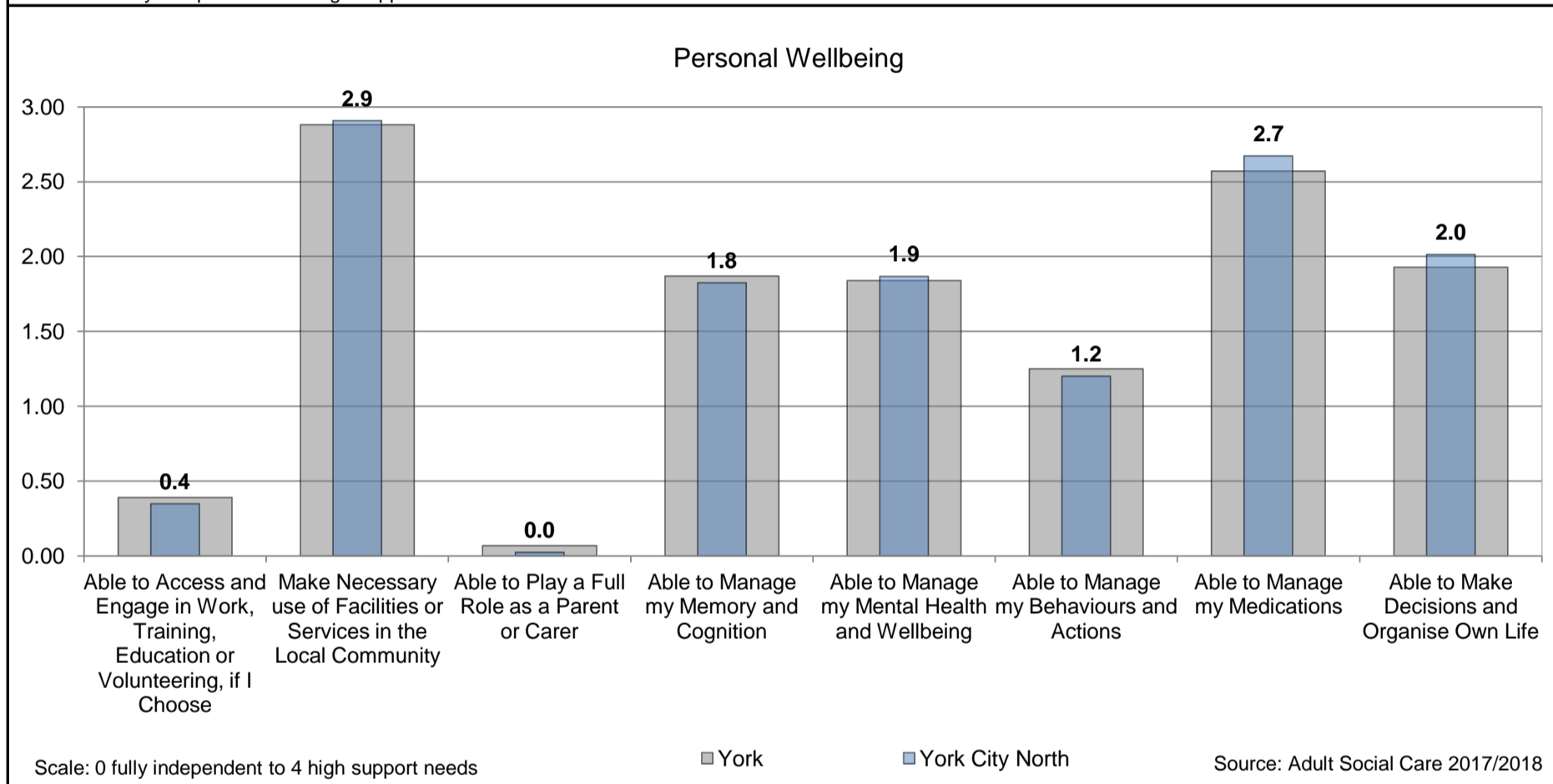
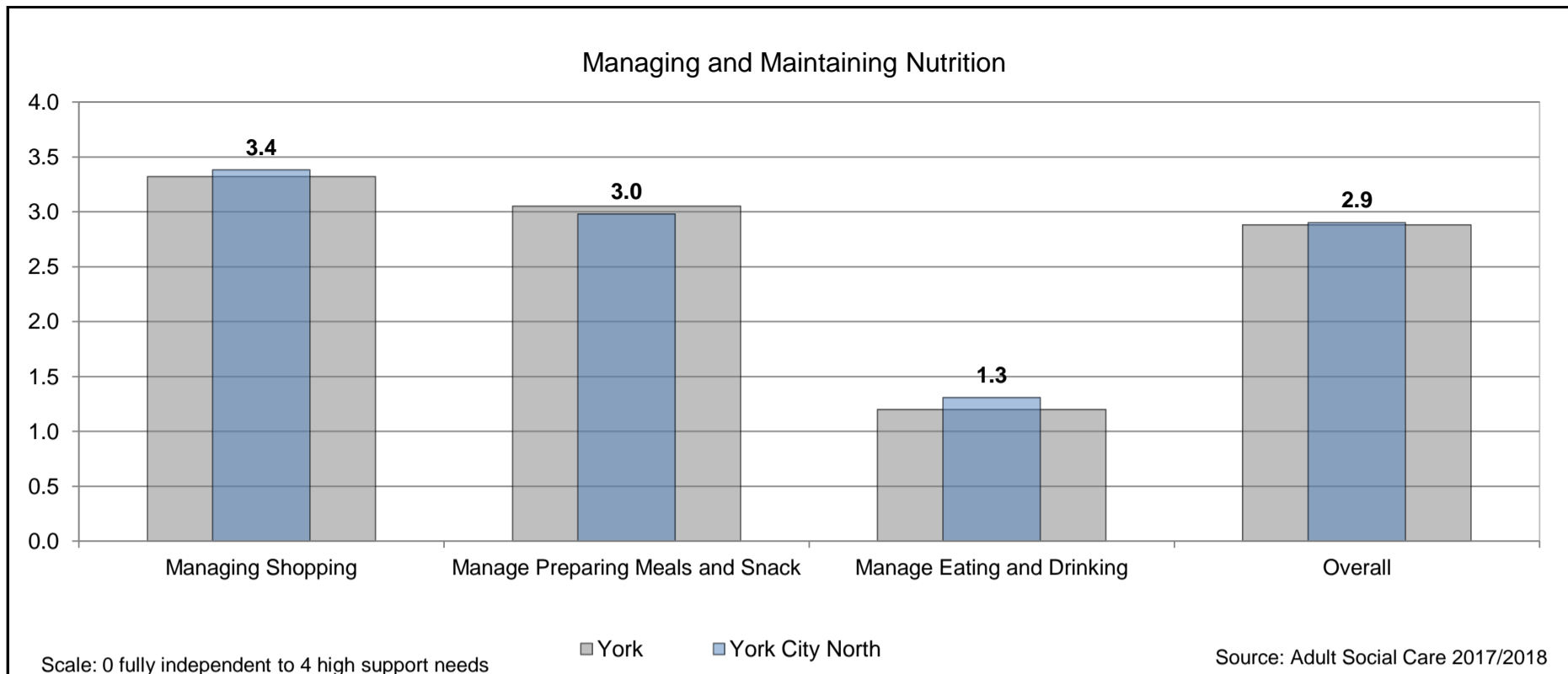

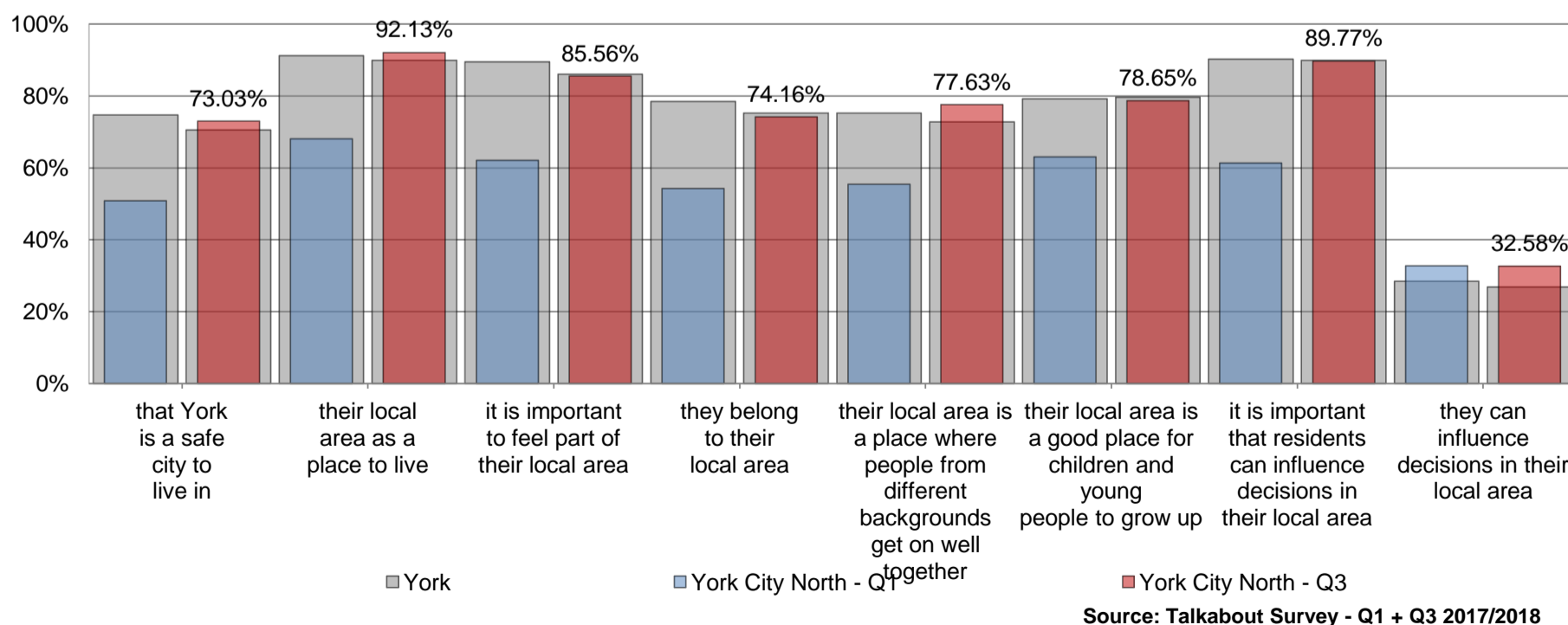

Respondents were asked to consider their local area as the area within 15-20 minutes walking distance from their home

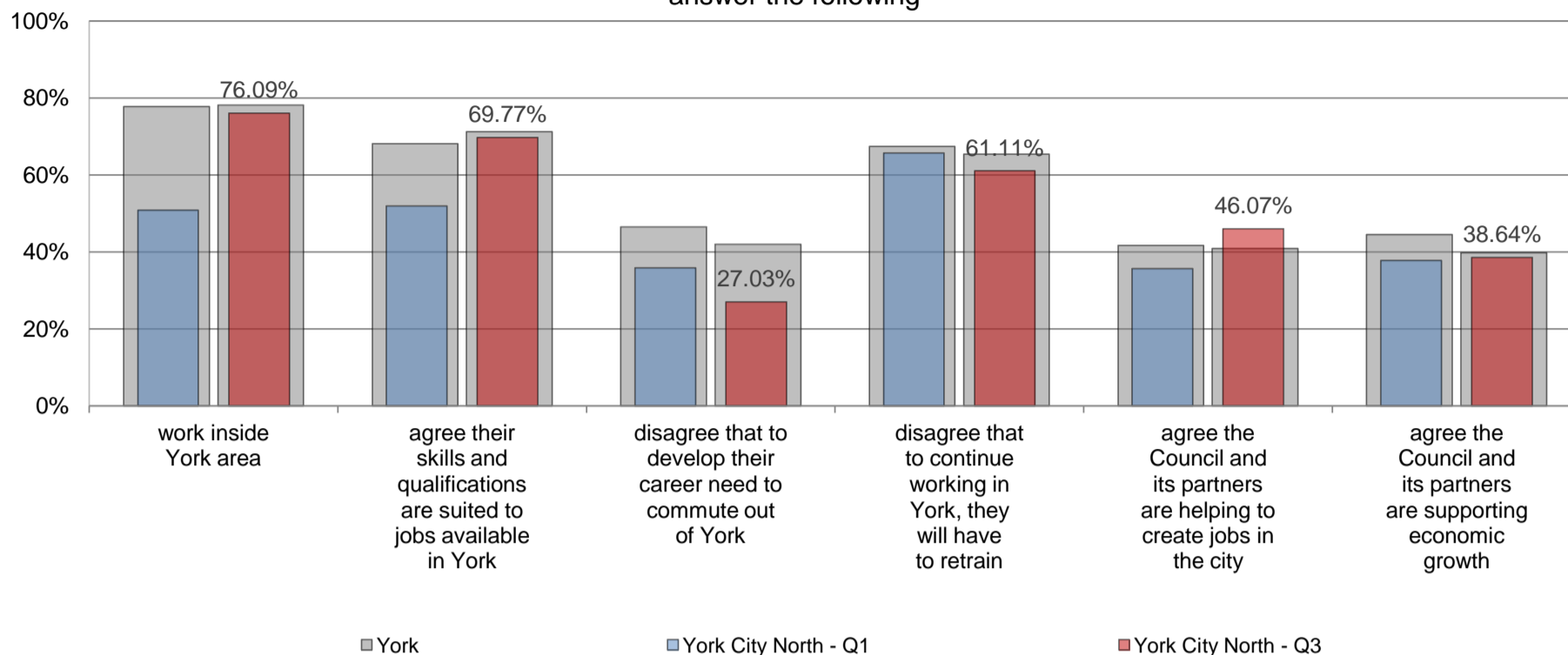

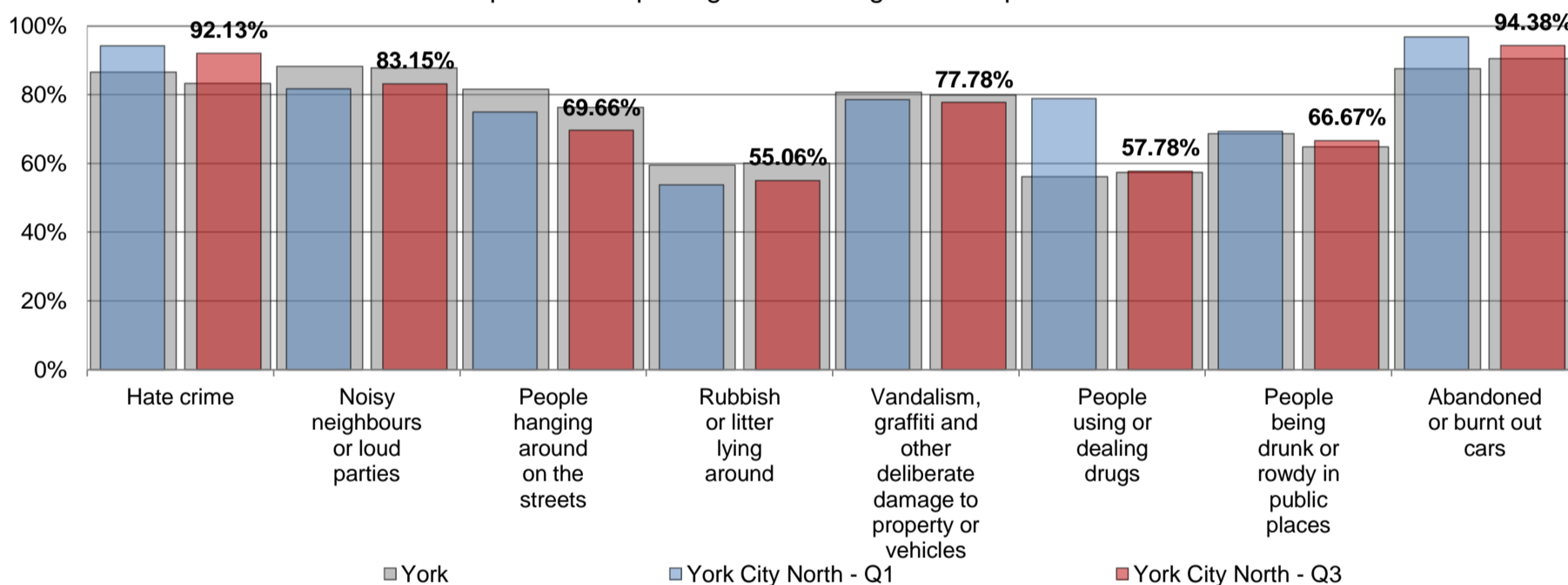

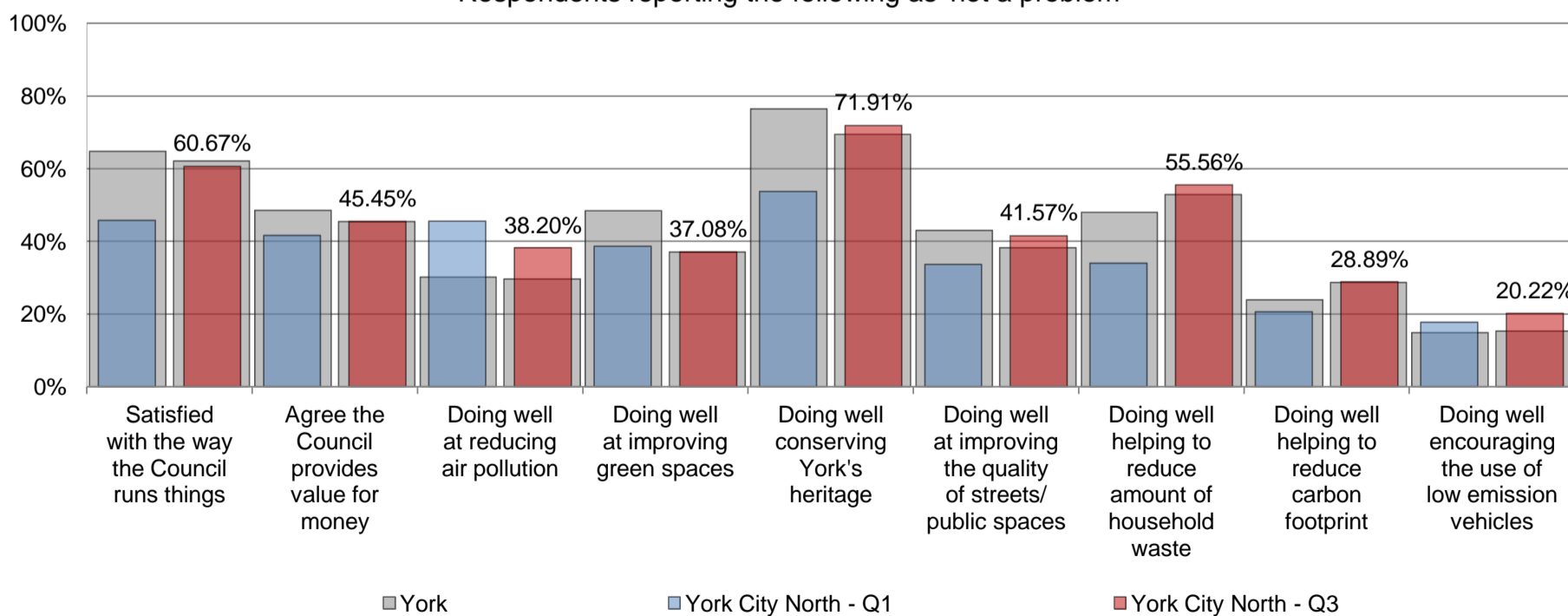
### Resident satisfaction responses about Public Realm in their Local Area

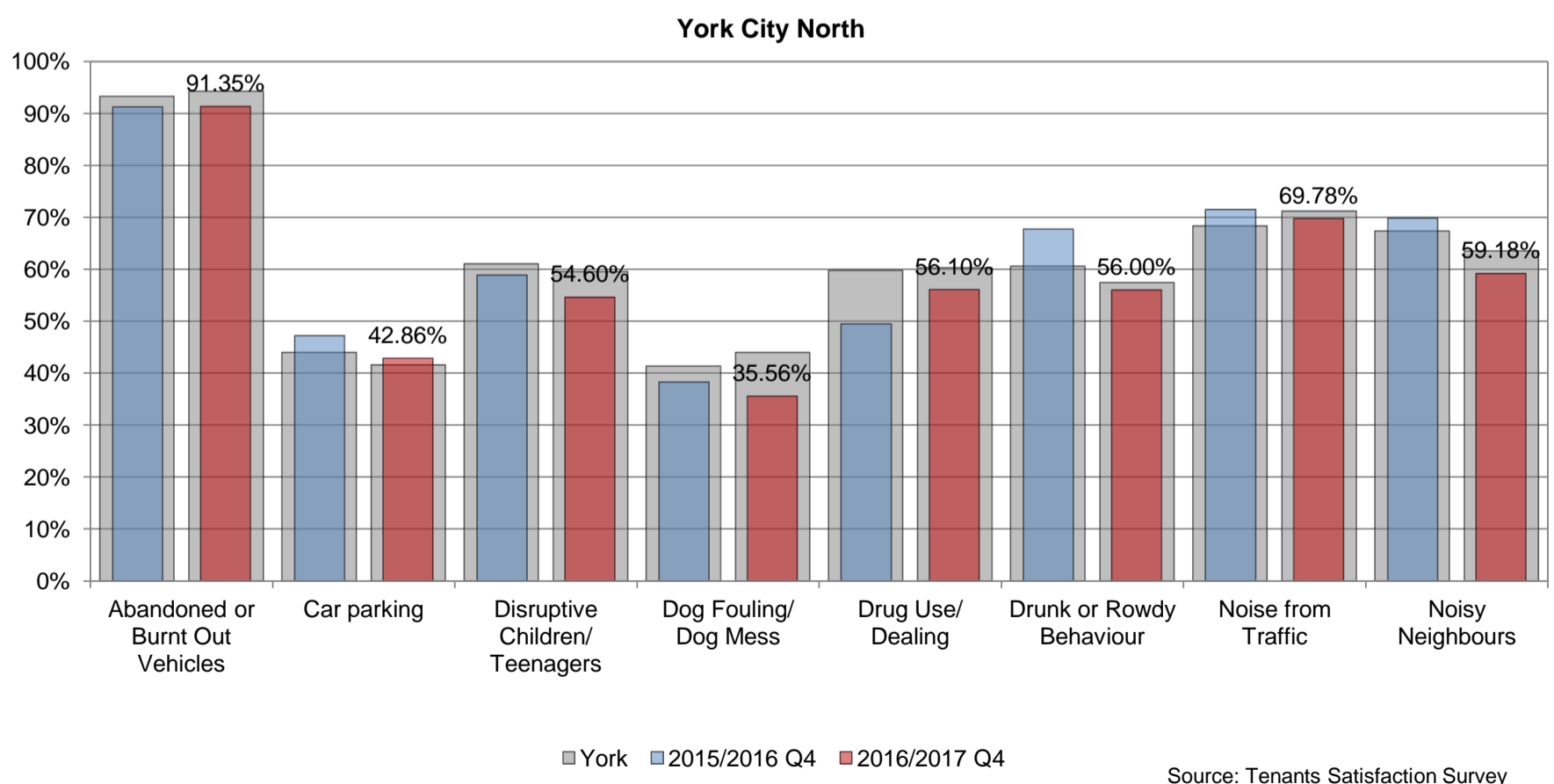

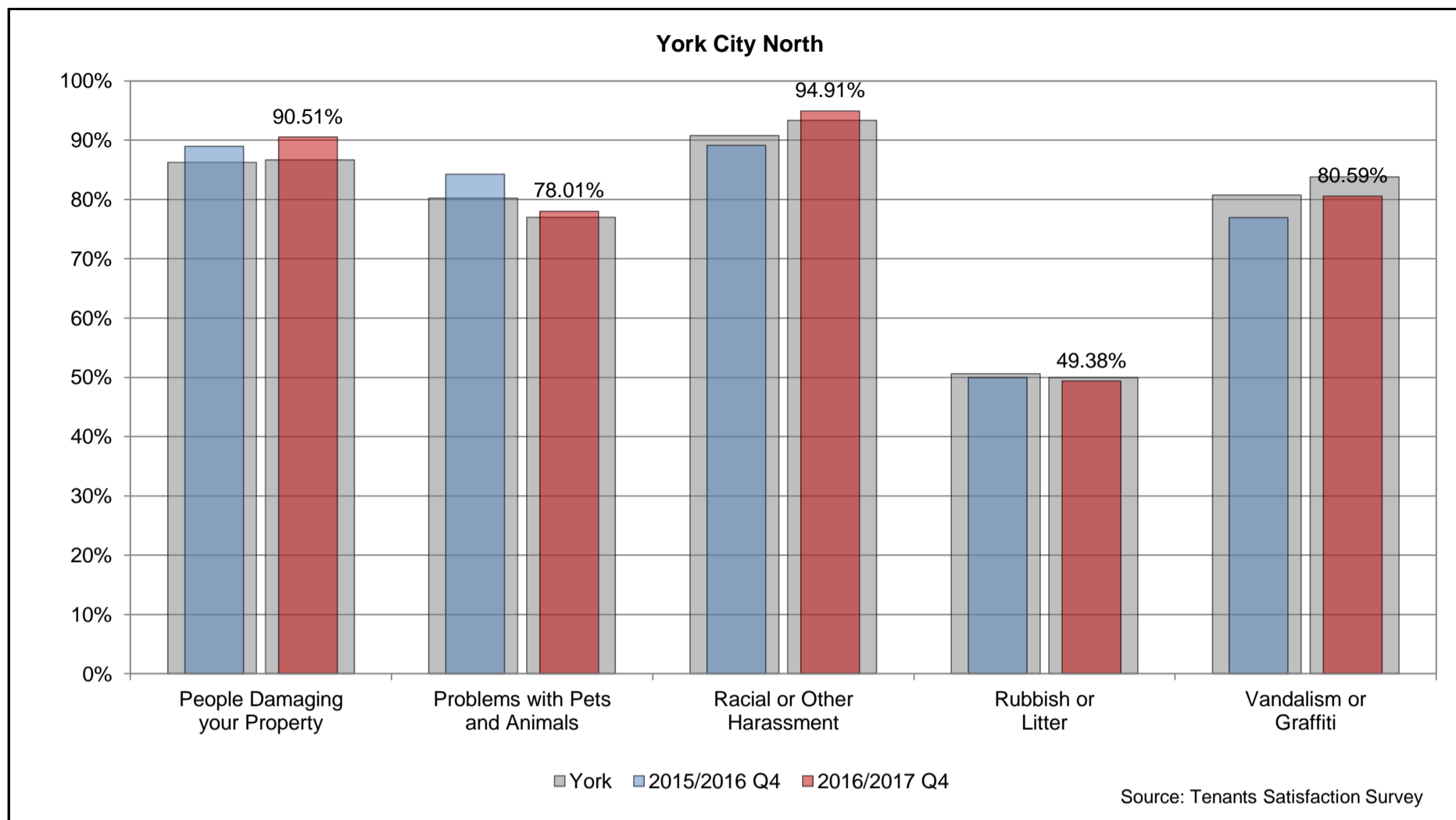


### York Council House Tenants Say is a Major Problem in their Neighbourhood.....
